## ORDINANCE 171010

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2017- (NEC) NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, AND THE MOST CURRENT (NFPA) NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION CODES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS AND ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE BY CITY OR REQUESTED INSPECTIONS, AND/OR CERTIFICATION OF SUCH COMPLIANCE WHEN REQUESTED/DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE CITY. THIS ORDINANCE IS NOT TO LESSEN ANY OTHER, STATE, OF FEDERAL LAWS, RULES, CODES, OR REGULATIONS. CONFLICTS BETWEEN CODES, LAWS, RULES, OR REGULATIONS SHALL OCCUR THE MOST STRINGENT AND LEGAL WILL PREVAIL.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAPELAND, TEXAS**

Section 1: The codes listed above are hereby adopted by reference as though it was copied herein fully. Any amendments or revisions made to the above codes by the NFPA will become a part of the appropriate code as though they were copied herein fully.

Section 2: If any matters in the code(s) are contrary to existing Ordinances of the City the most current will prevail or the most stringent as determined by the City and only the section in contrast is affected leaving the remaining sections intact for compliance.

Section 3: When within the code(s) referenced is made to the duties of certain officials named in the Code that official will be the individual(s) whose duties are corresponding to those of the named official in said code(s) and the City individual(s) will have the responsibility concerning enforcement actions or requiring certification or qualified third party inspection(s) acceptable to the City.

Section 4-Penalty: if any part of the code(s) is not complied with, the penalty shall be as Determined by the City or the Municipal Judge not to exceed \$500 and re-inspection(s) or Compliance acceptance action which will be not less than \$75 or more depending of time effort or cost for third party assistance (cost based invoiced amount or time, labor, travel, and any other cost factors)


Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
